

## **Historic Preservation**

Did you know homes in Lincoln Terrace are in a historical preservation district? Lincoln Terrace is part of the Capitol-Medical Center Improvement District and is governed by the CMCID Zoning Commission, which oversees development within and surrounding the State Capitol Complex and the OU Medical Center. That means, like other historic preservation districts, all exterior work on homes requires a certificate of appropriateness. To learn more, visit omes.ok.gov/services/capitol-medical-zoning.
