BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT- LINDSAY MEDIAN

If you've walked along the Lindsay Median in the past month or so you've probably noticed lots of new beautiful trees planted throughout the entire median! Nearly 40 trees of several varieties such as Burr Oaks and Deciduous Hollies have been planted. This neighborhood initiative was spearheaded by the Lincoln Terrace Board Association and Beautification Committee. Funding for the project came from generous donations from our neighbors along with grant money from the OKC Community Foundation. The next phase of the project will be installing a decorative planting bed on Lindsay and 16th street.



HOME IMPROVEMENT

Because we reside in a historic preservation district, it is required by the Zoning Commission to apply and receive a Certificate of Appropriateness before starting most renovation plans made to the outside of your home .
